**Panel Submissions – Due February 15, 2015**

Organizers are responsible for submitting the session title and abstract (of no more than **250 words**), keywords, length of session, presenter names and roles. Presenters are responsible for submitting their own individual abstracts (of no more than 100 words), paper title and keywords.

**Discussants and Chairs must be registered by final deadline.**

**Individual Paper and Poster Submissions – Due February 15, 2015**

Paper and Poster submissions should begin with paper or poster title, author's name (listed last name first in capital letters, then first name) followed by affiliation. The abstract should consist of no more than **100 words** with three keywords listed at the end of the abstract.
